Dear Fred Douglas Resident Families, Loved Ones and Designated Visitors;

On Wednesday, the provincial government announced immunization cards for fully-vaccinated Manitobans allowing expanded visiting at healthcare facilities. At this time, there are no changes to visitation guidelines at Fred Douglas Lodge. Only designated visitors are allowed in room visits, 1 visitor at a time.

Effective June 14th, designated visitors will be permitted to take residents outside to designated areas or for a walk in the vicinity of the Lodge.

Visitors to Spruce, Evergreen, and Willow will be allowed to visit on the Unit patios. Due to the size of the unit patios, a maximum of 4 people are permitted (2 residents, 2 visitors).

Visitors to Maple/Elm and Oak are allowed to visit in the Courtyard. Physical distancing from other resident and visitor groups must be maintained at all times.

Masks are still required for outdoor visits and eyeshields must be worn upon re-entry to the facility.

Residents must be signed out at the nursing station if you are taking them outside for a walk. During walks, visitors must wear their mask and it is recommended that residents wear masks if tolerated. Physical distancing from other people must be maintained.

General visitors are encouraged to book visits in the visitation room or outdoors. PPE is required for visits in the visitation room and outdoors. A maximum of 1 visitor is allowed in the visitation room, while a maximum of 2 visitors are allowed at an outdoor visit. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult. Inclement weather may result in the visit being cancelled.

Effective June 14th, the following visitor restrictions will be in place:

Designated Family Caregiver Visitors	General Visitors
In room visits allowed 9:30 AM – 5:30 PM Daily Last entry to the facility is 5:30 PM; All visitors must exit the facility by 6 PM	Visitation Room or Outdoor* visits only 9 AM – 5:45 PM Daily Last visit of the day begins at 5:15 PM *inclement weather may result in the visit being cancelled
Visitors may take residents to designated outdoor areas or for a walk in the vicinity of the Lodge	Pre-booked outdoor visits will take place in a designated area (Circle Drive).
Not required to schedule visit	Visit must be scheduled
Up to two (2) may be identified by the resident/delegate but <u>only one (1) may visit at a time in the resident's room</u>	Visitation Room – Max one (1) visitor Outdoor – Max two (2) visitors
Must complete screening process when entering the facility	Must complete screening process before visiting
Hand hygiene must be performed when entering/leaving Fred Douglas Lodge	Hand hygiene must be performed when entering/leaving the visitation room
Face mask and eyeshield will be provided and must be worn at all times	Face mask and eyeshield will be provided and must be worn at all times. Eyeshield not required for outdoor visit.
No food or beverages may be consumed while in the facility, including the residents room	No food or beverages may be consumed while visiting (indoor or outdoor)
Physical distancing must be maintained as much as possible	Physical distancing must be maintained at all times
Access to resident room washroom only	No washroom access
