Dear Fred Douglas Resident Families, Loved Ones and Designated Visitors;

Last week the provincial government announced immunization cards for fully-vaccinated Manitobans allowing expanded visiting at healthcare facilities. Effective June 21<sup>st</sup>, visiting guidelines are expanding to allow more social interaction between residents and their friends and family.

For designated visitors, there is little change to the guidelines. Designated visitors are still allowed to visit during visiting hours, 1 visitor at a time. Designated visitors do not need to prove vaccination status.

General visitors who are fully immunized will be allowed to visit fully immunized residents in their rooms. Please note, both the visitor and the resident must be fully immunized. There are specific drop in times for general visitors, please refer to the attachments. General visitors are required to present proof of vaccination and a photo ID at each visit. We do not keep this information on file.

Due to physical distancing requirements in resident rooms and the limited drop in times for general visitors, designated visitors may be asked to accommodate general visitors during the specified times. This means if a designated visitor is visiting during general visitor drop in times, the designated visitor may be asked to leave so that a general visitor can visit with the resident.

We strongly encourage family members to coordinate amongst themselves drop in times for visitors and the vaccination status of residents. Fred Douglas Lodge is unable to provide health information to non-designated persons. General visitors may be turned away at the door during drop in times based on the vaccination status of a resident.

Non immunized general visitors are encouraged to book an indoor pod visit or an outdoor visit.

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## *What does fully vaccinated mean?*

Fully vaccinated individuals are those who have received both doses (any combination) of an approved two dose COVID-19 vaccine (AstraZeneca, Pfizer, Moderna), OR a single dose of an approved single dose COVID-19 vaccine (Janssen/Johnson & Johnson) with more than 14 days having passed since the second dose (or approved sole dose) was received.

## *How do I prove I am fully vaccinated?*

Documentation may include:

- Confirmation via QR code (Manitoba immunization card)
- Paper version of Manitoba immunization card;
- Online confirmation of vaccine record through the Shared Health Online Results Portal <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/test-results/>
- Printout of vaccine record available through the Shared Health Online Results Portal <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/test-results/>

Facilities will confirm the identity of general visitors by requesting photo identification to match the name on the immunization record;

Designated Family Caregivers are not required to provide proof of vaccination.
